Trustee Badanes stated that when school starts it is exciting to hear the kids walking to school.

President Licopoli stated that today was opening day and the Superintendent make a presentation talking about goals. The Board of Education goals will be articulated in more detail at the September 15th meeting.

Superintendent Banzer stated that "we're back and it feels fantastic". It was certainly a team effort to get to this point. We are doing something big here each and every day. Mr. Banzer stated that he believes in the organization, in the staff, leadership and support staff. When we break things down into smaller goals

all those pieces lead to the bigger mission, bigger charge. An example of that was the 300 students involved in the tiger marching band and the energy that they brought to Superintendent's Conference Day.

Ninth grade orientation was held this week and the high school is cultivating a presence to make incoming student feel more comfortable. This incorporated older students as well.

Mr. Banzer stated that the District received \$25,000 in grant money from Assemblyman Brown to continue to work with a mentoring program. The District will be partnering with Mentor NY. Mr. Anthony Ferrandino, Student Assistant Counselor, is familiar with the program and it will move forward as a pilot program working with a group of students and Mentor NY to train students and staff in the importance of mentoring.

Assemblyman Brown stated that with everything going on with social media and bullying it was important to start a peer-to-peer mentorship program. The hope is to make this work in Northport and then blossom out to other districts. Plant the seed here in Northport and hopefully grow throughout Suffolk County and then throughout the State.
